## Instruct Students to Bring

## Class Preparation

1. Use Album 5" x 3¼" die to cut 40 straight-edge album pages from K&Company Recycled 4" x 6" Double-Sided Mat Pad (Wheat Print) adhered to kraft chipboard.
2. Use Fall & Winter die to cut 10 pumpkins from K&Company Recycled 12" x 12" Double-Sided Cardstock (Cream).
3. Use Vintage die to cut 10 rectangle Vintage shapes from K&Company Recycled 4" x 6" Double-Sided Mat Pad (Circle Print).
4. Use Album 5" x 3¼" die to cut 40 of the scallop-edge album pages from K&Company Recycled 4" x 6" Double-Sided Mat Pad (Circle Print).
5. Cut 10 mats (3¼" x ¾") out of K&Company Recycled 4" x 6" Double-Sided Mat Pad (Circle Print).
6. Cut 10 strips (3¼" x 1") out of K&Company Recycled 4" x 6" Double-Sided Mat Pad (Taupe).
7. Cut 10 pieces of 4" long and 10 pieces of 12" long Cajun ribbon.
8. Cut 20 pieces of 4" long and 10 pieces of 24" long Antique ribbon.

1	24" piece of Antique ribbon
2	4" pieces of Antique ribbon

## Alternate Ideas

- Use an AccuCut alphabet to cut out the letters instead of using packaged monograms.

## Tips

- Let students choose from the different ribbons on the card and let them use the ones they want to use.
- Have baby wipes on hand because inking can get messy.



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## Instructions

1. Using a brown ink pad, place each of the letters that spell “give” upside down onto the pad and push down until each one is covered. Repeat this same process with the chipboard heart.
2. Use sandpaper to sand around all four Wheat Print cards that will make the banner.
3. Using a sponge and the brown ink pad, lightly ink around the scalloped ends the Vintage shape, mini pumpkin and the two strips of paper.
4. Adhere scallop-edge shapes to the bottom of each card (holes are on the top) leaving about ½" of scallop showing.
5. Use Crate Paper® Transfers – Family Alphabet to spell out the word “thanks” on the 3¼" x 1" strip.
6. Adhere the other strip horizontally across the top of a card, leaving room for the “g” that will go below. Tie ribbon over strip and knot in front. Adhere the “g” to the page.
7. On the second card, adhere the “i” then adhere the pumpkin and heart to the lower left-hand corner.
8. On the next album page, adhere the rectangle Vintage shape in the center. Then adhere the “v” to the center of the Vintage shape.
9. On the last card, punch three holes going down the right side, starting the first hole 1" from the top. Tie on three 4" pieces of ribbon.
10. Adhere the strip with the word “thanks” to the bottom of the album page. Adhere the letter “e” to the card.
11. Place all the cards side by side to spell “give”. Thread the 24" piece of ribbon between the front and back of the holes. Follow this pattern through all the album pages until you get to the end.
